

The Big Bridge at Kussawa

which has long connected people walking on the Nakasendo, has been found to have changed in its construction over the years, from soil to wood and then concrete, according to documents from Kansei Era (1789-1801) to the present day.

In recent years, due to factors such as the flooding of Kussawa caused by the Isewan Typhoon of 1959 and Typhoon Forrest in 1983, the bridge was transformed into its current concrete state.

This bridge is still indispensable to residents of Yabuhara and for travelers walking the Nakasendo.
